#### Activities

#### 1. ICHTH–INTH Book Prizes

- Fora: The Book fora is not able to be published in *Storia* at this time. *Rethinking History* has agreed to publish the fora in alignment with its peer review policies, and it will appear some time between November 2024 and June. 2025. Reviewers have been identified, and the two books will have a presentation by the author, three reviews, and a rejoinder. Marek Tamm and Lisa Regazzoni will be guest editors under the guidance of Kalle Pihlainen. The Executive congratulates *Rethinking History*.
- Prizes: The process for the next prizes will commence in February 2025. The timeline is for the jury to be confirmed in March, with the ICHTH executive invited to the March meeting. It is anticipated that there will be an open call of the membership for at least one and potentially up to three members of the jury from the ICHTH. The call for books will open in May, the deadline will be December, and the announcement will be May 2026 at the INTH conference.

**Approval Sought from the Executive:** That the ICHTH continue with two prizes, one for best book and one for best first book.

**Note Forthcoming Meeting:** Members of the executive to attend the first meeting of the prize process, to support the process for the identification and confirmation of jury members.
